Claim: The Muslims claim that the Golden ratio exists in the wording of the Qur'an in Sura 3:96 with the word Mecca therefore Mecca is a set-apart site and must be by the creation by the servants of G-d.

First of all the Greenwich Meridian was invented by the British in the 19th century. In Addition, the measuring points are taken on a flat earth while our earth is not flat but a circle. The Qur'anic verse in question that Muslims cite is from Sura Al Imran 3:96 which does not even meet the claim.

The Golden Rule

First of all it does not meet the 47 characters in length. For those who do not read the Arabic which is the majority of the Western and Eastern world then these kinds of people are easily fooled by this trick of the hand.

The chapter of the Qur'an states the following;

Sura 3:96 The first house (of worship) appointed for men was that at Bakka: Full of blessing and of guidance for all kinds of beings:

إِنَّ أَوَّلَ بَيْتٍ وُضِعَ لِلنَّاسِ لَلَّذِي بِبَكَّةَ مُبَارَكًا وَهُدًى لِّلْعَالَمِينَ ﴿٩٦﴾

Sahih International

Indeed, the first House [of worship] established for mankind was that at Makkah - blessed and a guidance for the worlds.

Ps 135:3

Praise **ٱلَّهِ**; for **ٱلَّهِ** is good: sing praises to his name; for it is pleasant.

The wording 'Makkah' in the verse is an interpreter's interpolation because the Arabic word is Bakah.

This is the first anomaly that the word Mecca does not exist here for which the claim is laid.

The Arabic says Ina Awla Beyte Wadea Lilnas lilazy Bebakta.

The word Bayet is used a number of times in the Qur'an for people's homes which also negates the fact the verse in question is speaking about the Ka'ba because the house being spoken of is somewhere other than Mecca.

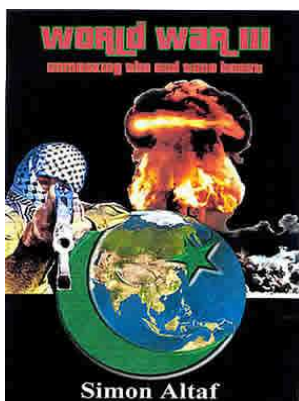
In fact the reality is that it is not unless you believe that the Ka'ba was built even before the first Tent for the dwelling of the shakinah glory was setup by the Almighty YHWH as his abode with the Y's-ra'elites. The verse in question is referencing a place at Baka and not Mecca at all. It appears many do not know much about ancient geography either, I would not blame the poor Muslims who buy into this kind of theology due to lack of education.

This particular place is mentioned in the Psalms in Ps 84:6.

Psa 84:6 (AFNHSS) Who passing through the valley of **Baca** make it a well; the rain also fills the pools.

This is a place in Northern Arabia connected with the End-Time judgment of the Islamic nations. This is where Sheba and Dedan, Ramah's sons dwelt who were Kushites.

Look at the map where Mecca is in relation to the valley of Baca.

They believed in the manifestation of "ba" at death to be eternal which would go and meet with the "ka" after death. The soul will be seen in Egyptian monuments as a flying bird with a human head.

The two joining together became known as Ka and ba or Ka'ba. So the Muslim shrine was made by Egyptian devotees to their false gods.

Next time someone talks about the Golden ratio being 1.618, remember it has nothing to do with Islam but more to do with the measurements at Egypt.

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Should I seek a sign for my marriage?

The first thing to look for is if the person is a Torah abiding believer in Messiah. This will indicate what level of maturity he has because if a believer is in the Messiah and does not hold fast to the Torah then he/she is unlikely to honour the relationship that you will be entering into. This is because they have no understanding of what is the role of the wife and what is the role of the husband. If there is ever an issue they will seek the quick escape route unless they understand what marriage is that they are entering into.

What if you did not know the roles?

The Torah is explicit that you enter into marriage to increase your seed or it could be for kingdom reasons.

Gen 1:28 Then Elohim Increased them, and Elohim said to them, Be fruitful, and multiply

It may be that you already have the children but are entering into plural marriage for other reasons such as attaching to the name of the man, home and a secure environment.

What is the role of the wife/wives?

The role of the wife is to look after all aspects of the home and children. This is a very demanding full time job in itself. She also has to look after the needs of the husband in that all the family is fed, clothed and washed, ironed. She is not just a cleaner for the husband but she will also meet the husband's spiritual needs such as the two petitioning together and doing things together for the kingdom. She will be there for her husband at the physical level as well as encouraging her husband spiritually. All this demands love from the wife and a caring attitude. The relationship is two way. Women are not created equal to men this is Satan's deception that a lot of people have bought into. A woman has equal rights but not equal in status there is a difference. Woman was created from the man and not vice versa. The idea that both are equal in status is the lie that is fed to many out there.

In order to fulfil her role a wife must submit to her head, the husband who in turn submits to Yahushua.

It may be that in a plural household one wife stays home to look after the children while the other wives work. They can be business oriented and this is perfectly legal in accordance with the Torah. The placing of wives is important especially if the husband is a business man or in kingdom building work. These being placed in different cities helps to spread the load of the work.

The role of the husband

He is the one to go out and work and to make sure that his wife/wives have enough income to meet the needs of the home they are caring for. In plural marriage the other wives can work and increase the household income.

The husband's role is also to be the head of the home and to be the spiritual warrior for his family. His role is to make sure his wives are instructed in the ways of YHWH. The family would come together every Sabbath to praise and give glory to YHWH. The husband should do this whole task with love and responsibility for his family at all times.

Is there any obligation for wives to meet on the Sabbath if they are living in different cities? The answer is no but they should under the direction of the husband celebrate the Sabbath. They may come together during the different festivals if that is something possible but again there is no legal Torah requirement to do so apart from the fact when the Temple was standing there was a commandment to go up to Jerusalem three times a year Deut 16:16. This commandment is currently suspended until the 3rd Temple.

Slothful husband and slothful wife

The slothful husband

Should I seek a sign for my marriage?

So what happened to all your signs that you were seeking and the husband still turned out to be slothful and worst still now you regret marrying him? This is why it is that we seek wisdom and not signs like the heathens. How could one have not known this earlier?

That is because you did not look for telltale signs in the man earlier.

Is he lazy, did you have to push him to get things done prior to your marriage?

If so this man was the wrong type to marry even if he is was a believer.

When you set times to meet him, did he turn up on time?

If he did not then this man cannot keep appointments he is careless! This will turn out to be the slothful husband, since he cares little for time then how much more so for his family and others around him.

How did this man treat animals around him such as family pets e.g. dogs, cats and fishes etc?

Did he kick them or throw them out of the house or had a general hatred towards them?

This tells us the man who can hit an animal may also lash out to his family such as children and wife. Even though we Torah people do not keep dogs in the house but some of us do have them in our farms or other places. This behaviour towards animals shows the man could make a potentially bad husband. The reason why dogs are not in homes is the extra responsibility to care for them and clean the house.

Can he boil an egg and do basic cooking?

If he cannot then can he learn it? If he is unwilling or does not want to then one must ask the question if the wife is ill then how will the husband cope with children and his sick wife? This is the wrong type of husband altogether to be married to.

The slothful wife

The woman who wants to be the sofa queen and do nothing in the home.

Tell tale signs.

She hates cooking.

She hates cleaning.

She hates washing up and ironing.

She just wants to read magazines, watch TV shows, go to the movies, eat in restaurants and do shopping.

If this is your fiancé then this is the wrong woman to marry even if she says she is a believer. Stay from such a sofa queen.

So in essence if you are depending on your marriage with signs then you have shown symptoms of bad wisdom indeed because you should be using the wisdom contained in the written words of YHWH to match the husband or wife. A fiancé who is honest, right-ruling, who cares for you, turns up on time is willing and goes the extra mile for you, can even cook is indeed hard to find in this age and this is the sort of person you want to be with for the rest of your life. This is the man or woman YHWH has for you whom you should endeavour to marry and look out for but if you have ended up with the wrong man or woman then now what?

First of all good communication is important and you can tell him if your husband/wife will listen. If not then the only avenue open is petition to the most high to fix the person. Remember it was you that chose to marry such a man. I know people who have chosen to marry with signs and their marriages have crumbled. A marriage is not about signs as the heathens look out for signs but not believers but its about a vow a contract that you make in front of YHWH to live with him for the remainder of your life. He may look handsome now or she may look pretty now but when age sets in will it be the same? No, then you need to take these things into account.

If you do not then its shows you did not think through things carefully.

There is always a next time so keep your eyes open and ears attentive.

How does one know if the man or woman they wish to marry is right? The easy way is to look at how they conduct themselves in the kingdom work and towards other people. Are they committed to Elohim? Many hours have been wasted by believer's petitioning Yahushua for a husband when the husband still turns out to be the wrong man. If Yahushua is going to give you a husband then He will send one but since he has already provided the example of one then why does he need to answer every individual prayer?

This unfortunately is where many are playing church but not the way of the Torah. According to Torah we petition before the man or woman appears before us. That is the indication if that person is right or not. We do not petition after we know the person and know everything there is to know. This is wasting Elohim's time and his provision. When Elie'zer Isaac's elder brother went to seek a wife for Isaac he petitioned YHWH before he met Rebecca and knew the instance she turned up and he gave her the nose ring and bangles.

Beresheeth 24:12-13 Then he said, O YHWH, Mighty One of my Adoni (master: father) Abraham, Please give me success this day, and show unmerited favour to my master Abraham. 13 Behold, I stand here by the well of mayim; and the daughters of the men of the city are coming out to draw mayim:

Eli'ezer was a wise son of Abraham; he did not waste time like most believers do today.

He asked exactly for what he needed and he got what he asked for before he even got there while many believers do not even know what they want.

If the man or woman is not right then you will know, there is no need to play mental gymnastics as some are doing. The easiest way to find out if a future husband or wife is suitable is to set a test/task for them and see if they do it or not and how well they do it. If they did it well then that is your husband or wife otherwise they are not. This is how Eli'ezer gauged the wife for Isaac.

What if my heart is not at peace? It is the heart which deceives men and women even today and man or woman have not changed.

Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is deceitful above all things, and incurably bad: who can know it?

The only way to know if you are at shalom is by looking, examining and interrogating. You are not a magician and don't pretend to be one. Believers deceive themselves by playing these games that I am not at peace what shall I do. When you petition once to YHWH after that you use wisdom to make sure that you are entering into the right relationship

I know of many believers with broken marriages with so called answered petition because they did not commit or follow through the relationship as one is meant to.

Marriage has to be worked at by both sides and that is how a strong bond is kept. There is no other magic formula. The women must help the man achieve the kingdom goals while the man is to shower love upon the woman and if the woman is not interested then no marriage will work while the same can be said for the man.

Today men and women are so lazy that they forget each other's needs and are self engrossed.

Last night while speaking with a couple of believers in Tanzania and South Africa it was clear to me that they were shocked to receive marriage advice which they had not even heard of before this is because they had only heard errant Christian Pastors give the wrong advice on marriages.

Many of our people need to snap out of the wrong doctrines that they have inherited from the Church.

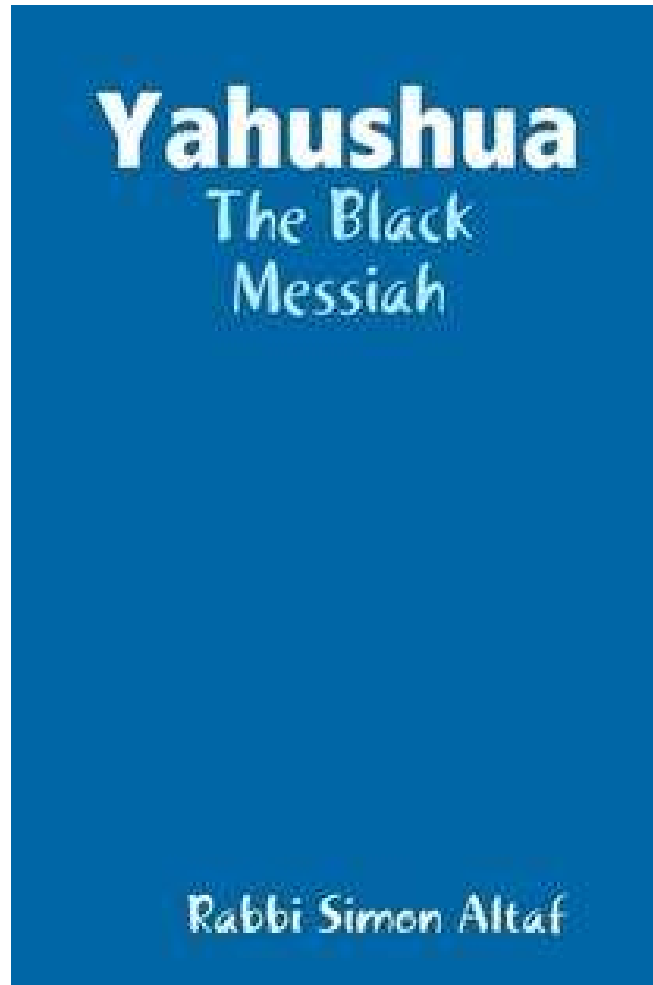
Addendum

If the woman supposes herself to be spiritually superior or more mature than the potential husband, while the man views himself as spiritually inferior to his fiancé'. This has much potential as a disaster. Why? Because if WHEN ENTERING THE ENGAGEMENT, the man supposes himself less mature in the faith than the woman, he will invariably forfeit his rightful role as spiritual head of the home from the beginning under the guise that his woman is "more spiritual". Then what will happen is the woman will rush in to fill the vacuum (if she hasn't already done so during courtship) and then set herself up to be the spiritual head of the home. This is of course is the complete opposite of Yahuweh's design, because the families of YHWH are supposed to be Patriarchal, NOT Matriarchal. So, consequentially, because the illegitimate power of her female-dominant matriarchy will corrupt her (yes, even if she is "Messianic" or whatever) she will get all sorts of fanciful notions of "G-d told me this" and "G-d told me that" and will use that convenient excuse to subjugate the man to her every whim with ever increasing severity- and this cancer will spread to all areas of marriage: child-rearing, financial, decision making, etc.. The bottom line, the man should seek out a woman who is spiritually compatible to him (similar spiritual level or slightly less mature in the faith than himself, that way he can truly be a leader).

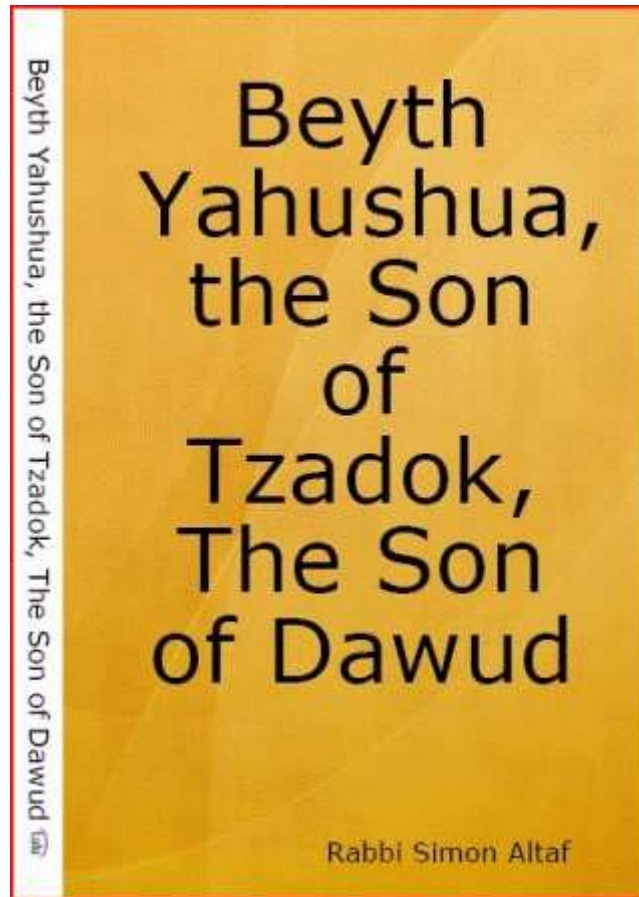
