Yahushua - The real Hebrew name for Jesus

YHWH - True name of the Father and Son pronounced as Yah-u-weh

Hebrew - Any man/woman member of the household of faith who is a part of the commonwealth of Israel, crossing over from death to life (Gal 3:29).

Essentially many stories can come out of this one and this applies to all times past present and future of the sojourn of Israel and Israelites amongst the nations and their behavior and lack of obedience. At the Drash (Allegorical) level this is the story of the two Houses of Israel, the House of Judah and the House of Israel how they behaved with the Father in heaven, what will happen to the House of Israel (The prodigal) and how after his disobedience he will go out in the nations and be scattered and he will adopt the filthy lifestyle of the nations and have no regard for clean/unclean holy/unholy things until he realizes (the time at which his punishment ends) and then he returns to the Father and joins back with Judah as a full member of Israel once again having regard for YHWH's Torah. The punishment for Ephraim was to last about 2700 years ending around 1996.

His elder brother Judah had regard for holy/unholy clean/unclean things and still does. He will lead in teaching the House of Israel how to keep obedience and teach Torah. The model of Levi will not break as they were always raised as teachers since they are a very small tribal clan mixed with Judah they will and are being

raised as I speak all around the world as righteous Torah teachers who know and are in relationship with the Messiah. This means many righteous teachers will be raised from the tribe of Judah/Benjamin/Levi these mixed and became one tribe called the House of Judah. How do I know this? I can prove this from scripture but the article here is to address the specifics of this prophecy which I shall do now. These teachers will teach the scattered Ephraimites (The Ten tribes) how to serve the Father and will prepare them for the coming of the great King of Kings Yahushua of Nazareth.



1 John 2:4

He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, [Keep Torah] is a liar, and the truth is not in him.

Luke 15:11-12 Then He said: "A certain man had two sons. (12) "And the younger of them said to his father, `Father, give me the portion of goods that falls to me.' So he divided to them his livelihood.

Yahushua starts with a certain man and who is this certain man in the parable with two sons.

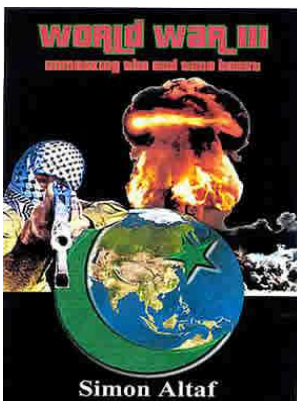
The certain man is Drash (Allegory) of the Father in heaven and the two sons represented are Judah and Ephraim.

Jer 31:20 "Is Ephrayim a **precious son** to Me, a child of delights? For though I spoke against him, I still remembered him. That is why My affections were deeply moved for him. I have great compassion for him," declares **יהוה**

Judah and Ephraim are the two sons

1 Chronicles 5:1-2 Now the sons of Reuben the firstborn of Israel he was indeed the firstborn, but because he defiled his father's bed, his birthright was given to the sons of Joseph, the son of Israel, so that the genealogy is not listed according to the birthright; (2) yet Judah prevailed over his brothers, and from him came a ruler, although the birthright was Joseph's

The Inheritance was given to Ephraim or Joseph from whence Ephraim would be. The scepter (Kingship) remained with Judah hence the Messiah would come out of them to gather and unite both Houses of Israel which is the job of a Messiah figure in this case Yahushua.

Hosea 1:11 Then the **children of Judah** and the **children of**

Israel shall be gathered together, and appoint for themselves one head; and they shall come up out of the land, for great will be the day of Jezreel!

What many commentators do not realize is that the term “children of Judah” applies primarily to the Yahudim meaning Jewish Israel.

Deuteronomy 4:6 Keep them and do them; for that will be your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples, who, when they hear all these statutes, will say, 'Surely this **great nation** is a wise and understanding people.'

The Hebrew term for surely this “great nation is a wise and understanding people” is the term “ חכם ונבון הגוי הגדול הזה: .”

xhakaam wnaabown hagowy hagaadowl hazeh.

The words that interest us are in this phrase “Hagoyee Ha gadowl”, once we understand these our path is then set straight. YHWH prophesied through Moses the great prophet of Israel that Israel was to become great gentile nations. Within YHWH’s judgment is hidden mercy so while YHWH threw the House of Israel out of Israel He extended His hands of mercy to fulfill the prophecy He gave to Abraham then to Isaac and then to Jacob that Israel the Ten Tribes would become many “company of gentile nations” Melo Ha Goyim Gen 48:19 that means completely non-Jewish.

The problem occurs when most people see the term “children of Israel” and try to equate that to Jewish Israel only and then it doesn’t work. These people the ten tribes are non Jewish all Ten clans referred to by the name House of Israel. They were living in a separate state as their own country Northern parts of Israel. This was the enmity between Judah and Ephraim while the Messiah will come to remove that enmity to join the two as one stick. Ephraim is the son who asked the Father to give me my inheritance so that I may leave. This is the picture of the ten Northern tribes who departed from the **way of YHWH** to the **way of the world**. They had a rich inheritance but they decided to forsake all this for the vain glory of the world. They took their inheritance and went out **whoring** for other elohim and then got into eating unclean and had no regard for any of Torah provisions what is clean or unclean.

This picture fits perfectly with Modern Christianity that has many both spiritual and biological members of Israel who have no regard for clean/unclean holy/unholy days. They shunned what was Right and rejoiced in what was wrong with their unclean feasts and unclean foods. Let us explain this a bit more.

Christmas is unclean and a pagan feast yet many Christians struggle to give it up. The typical response given is our children are so used to it so what can we tell them. How about tell them the truth and put a stop to it. This would be the most loving and honest thing to do. Christmas has no connection with Yahushua's birth what so ever because He was born in September the Biblical month of Tishri on the 15th day which is the first day of the Feast of Tabernacles in the year of His birth. Eating unclean foods is also part of the common culture western society yet the page for our diet is in Leviticus 11 and Deuteronomy 14 but for centuries the Christian anti-Semitic church fathers have been telling Christians that these pages are for the Jewish people only so the only thing Christianity has to do is attend Sunday worship which is an unclean day dedicated to the sun worship (Eze 8:16) by the Roman's in the past which YHWH actually forbids but most Christians think that they can come to the Father as they please.

Recently in the British news some teacher told the schools children that Santa Claus was fake and made up by the parents and this caused an uproar and the poor teacher was fired from her job, this is what happens to those who try to tell the truth to those who want to live in fantasy land.

Primary school teacher who told children: 'Santa does not exist' is fired By Daily Mail Reporter

A primary school teacher who left a class of 25 pupils in tears after she told told them Santa Claus did not exist has been fired..

When excited youngsters became rowdy as they talked about Santa, the supply teacher blurted out: 'It's your parents who leave out presents on Christmas Day.'

The class of seven-year-olds at Blackshaw Lane Primary School, Royton, near Oldham, Greater Manchester burst into tears and told their parents when they arrived home.

Santa sacked: A teacher has been told not to return to work after she told her primary school pupils that Santa Claus is not real

Mothers and fathers then complained about the incident and were sent a letter by the school saying the substitute teacher, who only worked at the school for one day last week, has been disciplined. The school has now said it will not hire her again.

One father said: 'My son came home and said that his substitute teacher had told the class that Santa doesn't exist and it'lls your mum and dad that put out presents for them. 'Apparently, they were all talking about Christmas and being a bit rowdy. She just came straight out with it. 'My lad was in tears and so was everyone else in the class - especially as it was so close to Christmas.

'I thought it was wrong. He was distraught about it. He's only seven-years-old and it's part of the magic of Christmas to him. 'We told him that she did not believe in Father

Christmas because of her religion and he's fine now.' The father described the incident as 'shocking' and believed it was done with malicious intent.

'A lot of parents were disgusted and complained to the school.'

The teacher, who was supplied by Rochdale and Oldham Supply Agency, is still registered and will work with other schools, the agency said.

Headteacher Angela McCormick refused to comment on the incident.

Quite clearly its ok to lie to your children and if someone has the courage to tell the truth then it is considered as you can read in this report insensitive. If this is how parents behave no wonder the kids grow up to be accepting many untruths as standard practice.

Many Christians continue to behave like the gentile nations even calling themselves "gentile" but Hebraically the word gentile was to describe "heathens" meaning those who have no regard or knowledge of the Holy One of Israel. One has to accept then that perhaps the word they use for themselves describes their behavior adequately!

Judah is the second son in this parable represented as the elder who stayed with the Father and did not depart from the Father's ways and kept the feasts and keeps the Torah while Ephraim does not have any regard for Torah because Ephraim was taught that the Torah is not for you. Ephraim called Yahuweh's Torah strange.

Hosea 8:12 I have written for him the great things of My law (Torah), But they were considered a strange thing.

Justin Martyr one of the anti-Semitic church father circa 2nd century AD in his debate with Trypho the Jewish man. Even Trypho hit the nail on the head about Christian's bad behavior towards YHWH's Torah but poor Justin did not really have much understanding in that area. This has been going on for at least 1800 years the anti-Torah people. Pick any denomination of Christianity and ask them do you keep Torah? The response is what is Torah? Ask them are you Hebrew they will say no we are gentiles! That about ends the discussion, anything else would just offend them too much so at this stage its just best to leave and not get into a heated debate. You cannot debate people who lack education in Scripture.

But this is what we are most at a loss about: that you, professing to be pious, and supposing yourselves better than others, are not in any particular separated from them, and **do not alter your mode of living from the nations, in that you observe no festivals or Sabbaths, and do not have the rite of circumcision;** and further, resting your hopes on a man that was crucified, you yet expect to obtain some good thing from God, while you do not obey His commandments. [Bold mine]

It's ironic that Trypho spoke about the heavenly man that the Christians worship who we

know to be Yahushua who became circumcised on the 8th day yet many Christians refuse to fulfill this eternal ordinance under the guise of Paul said this and Paul said that!

Trypho though did not believe in Yahushua but was very critical of Justin for the way most Christians had decided to live at that time they did not circumcise, keep the weekly Sabbaths or the feasts. Trypho was right about the mismanagement of Torah belief and not keeping the Sabbaths, feasts, circumcision but was wrong about our hope in Yahushua though it is clear that not keeping of Torah had become a stumbling block for all subsequent Jewish people throughout the centuries and they had to endure much ridicule and scorn for it.

The second stumbling block was the Babylonian cross while Yahushua was impaled on a Tree (Acts 5:30, 1 Pet 2:24). I am not at all surprised when I see this cross worn by many stars in the film and song industry, the other place is by gangsters, they think bigger the better with diamond studded in it like a voodoo charm. The early believers did not use this as a symbol because it never was. This pagan cross speaks volumes to me how it clings to the unrighteous people of this world and is used by clergy who also behave badly like the world working for their own unrighteous goals. Yahuweh did not hang His Son on a pagan cross to justify pagan law but justified His own righteous law (Deut 21:23) that we all broke by hanging Him on a Tree on the Mount of Olives and you won't find any ancient crosses there.

Trypho was true that the Christians had made a bad example of the way they lived to do away with Torah was the wrong thing that many were taught and as early as 160AD these things had come into the churches where everything that the Disciples and Apostles of Yahushua practiced (Torah) taught it between 34AD to 90AD had now been rejected and disregarded altogether as unprofitable.

First St. Ignatius made sure that the people were subjected to him as the Bishop.

Chapter II.—Be subject to the bishop, etc.

For, since ye are subject to the bishop as to Jesus Christ, ye appear to me to live not after the manner of men, but according to Jesus Christ, who died for us, in order, by believing in His death, ye may escape from death. It is therefore necessary that, as ye indeed do, so without the bishop ye should do nothing, but should also be subject to the presbytery,

We see the hatred Ignatius had for the covenant people while the attitude of Paul and early believers was completely different.

Chapter VI.—Do not accept Judaism.

But if any one preach the Jewish law unto you, listen not to him. For it is better to hearken to Christian doctrine from a man who has been circumcised, than to Judaism from one uncircumcised. But if either of such persons do not speak concerning Jesus Christ, they are in my judgment but as monuments and sepulchers of the dead, upon which are written only the names of men

OK, at least he said listen to the one who is circumcised and in Messiah that sounds like Rav Shaul (Rabbi Paul) and all the early Disciples who were circumcised and teaching truth. This thing started with the Bishop of Antioch St. Ignatius who usurped the authority of the early Jewish Bishops to erect a new religion called Christianity in Turkey. No wonder Yahushua pointed out the faulty assemblies in Turkey. In fact all seven assemblies were there. Torahlessness (non keeping of the commandments like Kosher food, Sabbaths and Feasts) started from Turkey and spread worldwide. Yahushua tells these in the book of Revelation return to your first love meaning return to the commandments taught because Hebraically love is to “obey” it is a verb and nothing to do with the Eros kind of love the church seems to be into and teaching all the time. The love sermons just don’t seem to disappear and are like a broken record continuously being played. The seven churches in Turkey also at the Remiz (Hint) speak of the Islamic Empire and the End Time beast engulfing all of Christianity and destroying many so beware especially if you are Torah-less you are marked already.

This is why we see homosexual Christians (If it is lawful to call them that) who live in complete sin and claim love and mingle with others. This kind of nonsense can only exist in Western churches such things cannot be upheld as truth but perversion at the highest level sometimes may be acceptable to the high order clergy for what they term making peace. We see today the Marcion error which eventually found its way into all mainstream churches in the 21st century where Paul becomes the creator and he becomes the dictator of all laws while ignoring corpus of testimony of the Torah, prophets and Yahushua about set-apart living. Yahuweh is taking the prodigal son back to His Hebrew roots away from the Ignatius model of Christianity where there was no regard for anything Scriptural. Christians sing “open the eyes of my heart lord” and they really need to be opened by the Master Yahuweh and He has begun to open them through teachers He is raising. First He will send fishers and if they do not listen then He will send the hunters.

These are Justin’s sentiments which sum up what I said above with no regard to Torah in Christians in Justin’s time.

For the law promulgated on **Horeb is now old**, and **belongs to yourselves alone**; but *this* is for all universally. Now, law placed against law has abrogated that which is before it,

Men like Justin and Ignatius had decided that YHWH’s law is old and outdated and this is why the prodigal son was/is into unclean/unholy things.

“Give me the portion of goods that falls to me”

When the son Ephraim asked for his inheritance what he was saying essentially is Dad as far as I am concerned you have died and I want my inheritance because in the East one would only get his inheritance when the father was dead. This grieved the father that he lives yet his son wants the inheritance and had already decided that he was dead as far as he was concerned.

Luk 15:13 “And not many days after, the younger son, having gathered all together, went away to a distant country, and there wasted his goods with loose living.

The son went to a “far away” country. This was when YHWH cast off Ephraim the Ten tribes the House of Israel to the Assyrian captivity. The Assyrian lands were half of modern Turkey to Pakistan. Most of these lands are Muslim today. Essentially at that time they would be worshipping the false elohim of the Assyrians and even today they do the same. While some have come back to the Messiah of Israel but still hold to unholy practices. Those that heard the voice of Yahushua and came out still remain in mixed worship of pagan days and pagan deities. Calling yourself messianic makes no difference because many still do not know how to keep the feasts or obey the Sabbath laws. They are very much behaving like heathens and also call themselves gentiles. Go ask them and they will tell you they are gentiles not even understanding they are calling themselves heathens and not Hebrews.

They do not know the difference between Allah and YHWH and think both are one and the same so mix deity names. Same goes for the many deities of India who are mixed and mingled in with Hindu/Christian worship. Such is the state of these places of worship.

“Wasted his goods with loose living”

Ephraim wasted what inheritance he had and that inheritance was the covenants that were made with the forefathers like Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Ephraim a picture of modern Christianity wasted the goods (covenants) with loose/riotous living meaning had no regard for Torah or practicing it. In the picture is also the idea that the younger son had no regard for what he had but decided it was not what he wanted and so while living amongst the gentiles became one like them a full heathen. This is why the Jewish Talmud for all practical purposes calls Ephraim a goyim (Heathen nations).

Hos 8:11 “Since Ephrayim has made **many altars for sin**, they have been altars for sinning to him.

Many Altars for sin

One altar of sin is the feasts that Christians call holy while many lack discernment that the feasts that they are given are from paganism and an altar for sin.

Christmas, Easter were linked to false elohim at one time and one needs to be careful what he does with them today as they only help to revive the spirits of those false deities who are nothing but poisonous demons.

Second Altar for sin

Unclean food is now clean according to modern theology but not according to Torah. People are taught if you pray over bacon, pork, oyster, crabs and lobster then it becomes clean. This is an error because unclean does not become clean by a prayer but remains unclean to the point that one day it will kill the consumer of that food.

Many people do not realize that prawns are vermin of the sea and eat dead flesh that carries diseases which will then transmit to the human race. Pigs were designed to be environmental

cleaners and are biologically speaking walking garbage bins. They eat dead meat, rubbish and other bits and pieces and enjoy living in muck. In one place in Philadelphia they used pigs to help get rid of the rubbish because they feed on it and it saved the state millions of dollars.

Now ask yourself would you eat your kitchen bin? If you are then imagine the contamination your body is going through and what your inside will be like.

Pigs are highly adaptable and will generally consume anything available, ranging from plants, leaves, grasses, worms, snails, and eggs to rotting carcasses, excrement, garbage, disease-ridden rodents, and other animals (Dewey and Hruby).

By consuming these meats one is putting their life in grave risk of disease or early death.

2Ch 29:16 And the priests came into the inner part of the House of יהוה to cleanse it, and **brought out all the uncleanness** they found in the Hēkal of יהוה to the courtyard of the House of יהוה. Then the Lēwites received it to take it outside to the wadi Qidron.

Note the priests went into the inner chamber of the Temple and brought out all the unclean items they found. Yahushua shed His blood and by applying His blood to our body the Temple of the Ruach are we going to allow Yahushua to cleanse and bring out all our UNCLEAN items or are we going to insist that we must continue to feed on unclean items?

2Ch 29:17 And they began to set apart on the first day of the first month, and on the eighth day of the month they came to the porch of יהוה. And they set apart the House of יהוה in eight days, and on the sixteenth day of the first month they had finished.

Note also that this happened on the first day of the first month. What is the first month and what special event happened on it? The first Biblical month is Abib also referred to as Nissan the Messiah was impaled and hung on a tree on Passover for the whole of Israel both houses and any other gentiles that wanted to join Israel. The text says they set-apart the House of YHWH for eight days and continued for sixteen days total before the work was finished.

Here scripture is pointing to two eights meaning a Remiz could be applied for the first 8th days and the second 8th day meaning the feast of Tabernacles has a great day and since Yahushua was born on the feast of Tabernacles He established us with great rejoicing on the first feast of His birth.

Now He will return to give us the 2nd 8th day of the great feast by raising us if we are dead so we will join the Millennium which is the 7th day but after the Millennium comes the 8th day not the first day when Satan will be released for a time and then Yahushua will seal His

victory by vanquishing Satan and all his cohorts and bring the whole world into judgment while we will be partaking all of that if we faithfully walk with the master today we have already experienced the first great day by being washed in the blood of Messiah and rejoicing in our salvation and we will enter the next great day to see our Messiah Yahushua put away all evil for good and take us into the eternal order.

Ezekiel 22:26 "Her priests **have violated My law** and **profaned My holy things**; they have not distinguished between the **holy and unholy**, nor have they made known the difference between the unclean and the clean; and they have hidden their eyes from My Sabbaths, so that I am profaned among them.

Many in Christendom are not taught the difference between clean/unclean so remain in disobedience due to their own lack of education about the importance of such things. The burden of responsibility falls on the Pastor's and priests for propagating what I term the Ignatius error but it still does not excuse the individual for not going and getting instructions from reliable teachers!

Luke 15:13 "And not many days after, the younger son gathered all together, journeyed to **a far country**, and there wasted his possessions with prodigal living.

The far country was the Assyrian Empire but by extension the whole world as leaven spreads very fast as we can see in modern Christianity uncleanness remains in many churches. No regard or due diligence is paid to the covenants of YHWH and everything seems to be split up in two covenants old covenant termed by the Christians the Hebrew Bible wrong again because the Torah the first five books alone has eight covenants followed by repetitions and at least one new covenant in the prophets. The term "old" does not exist for any covenant of YHWH yet this error is propagated by Christian pastor's weekly. The Bible says a little leaven leavens the whole lump.

Gal 5:9 A little **leaven** leaveneth the whole lump.

Now we would understand why many Christians end up in error by following those who are not willing to teach or do not have the understanding of Torah truth verses error? Muslims are not wrong to object about the purported Pauline Christianity practiced in many churches. This was the error of Marcion who cobbled up Paul's letters and removed what he did not like! I term Rabbi Paul as the idle of Christianity who people use to break Torah by not understanding his difficult words. Friends if Shaul walked into any church today he would think he has entered a different faith to the one he practiced and fought so hard for.

Act 20:29-30 "For I know this, that after my departure **savage wolves¹** shall come in among you, not sparing the flock. **Footnote: ¹See Mt. 7:15-23, Mt. 10:16, Lk. 10:3, John 10:12. (30)** "Also from among yourselves men shall arise, speaking distorted *teachings*, to draw away the taught ones after themselves.

The prophecy he gave about the overseers devouring the sheep with no regard for what he

taught has already fulfilled and no church would recognize him today a Benjamite wearing head coverings, katan, tzitzits and shawl. They would think he is a nutcase acting Jewish. The state of the assembly today is much worse than in Corinth.

Luke 15:14 "But when he had spent all, there arose a severe famine in that land, and he began to be in want.

The famine arose as a result of many years of disobedient living. The famine is allegorical of spiritual growth and physical need. Yahushua said a man cannot live by bread alone but when the words of Elohim are missing and are being replaced by fodder then why bemoan when Yahuweh has allowed Islam to run over the churches and Christian places for disobedient living.

Amo 8:11 "See, days are coming," declares the Master יהוה "that I shall send a hunger in the land, not a hunger for bread, nor a thirst for water, but for hearing the Words of יהוה."

The hunger is not for physical food but for spiritual true teachings found in Scriptures. Without Torah it just won't add up.

Luke 15:15 "Then he went and joined himself to a citizen of that country, and he sent him into his fields to feed swine.

Ephraim not only joined to the citizen of that country but became the citizen himself and started eating unclean and living unclean like the other citizens.

Luke 15:16 "And he would gladly have filled his stomach with the **pods that the swine ate**, and no one gave him anything.

The swine is unclean but even the pods they eat in would become unclean so if an unclean item touches a clean item it too becomes unclean yet Ephraim was happy to eat the unclean. Friends many in assemblies teach to just say a little prayer over any type of food and voila it is now clean this is not true.

Luke 15:17 "But when he came to himself, he said, `How many of my father's hired servants have bread enough and to spare, and I perish with hunger!

When Ephraim's punishment is finished he suddenly wakes up and realizes that His Father's house is full meaning Israel's has all the knowledge and Judah is relishing in it but poor Ephraim is stuck out in the nations and starving from the true words of YHWH being fed error of dispensationalism, error of eating unclean, error of pre-trib escapist rapture and many other errors like Messiah died on Calvary.

Singing errors every sun-day (ascribed to the sun goddess) does not make it true!!! Even the day for corporate worship is unholy, Mikra Qodesh gathering of the assembly (Lev 23:2) is

commanded on a Sabbath Friday sundown to Saturday sundown never Sun-day.

When He was actually hung on a tree on the Mount of Olives not Calvary, He was not on a Babylonian cross which you see many film stars, singers wearing but on a Tree according to Torah law Deut 21:22, pelted with stones that caused a quick death. The tree was on the Mount of Olives and He was buried nearby on the same Mount and He will also return on the Mount of Olives. Judah faithfully keeps the feasts while Ephraim has to be happy on the untruths he feeds on.

When the punishment ends Ephraim wakes up and realizes he needs to leave and go back home where the nourishment is and where his Father awaits him with open arms though he thinks for his disobedience he might be lucky to get employment as a servant in his father's house but forgets the bounty of love his Father has for him.

Luke 15:18 ` I will arise and go to my father, and will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you.

Ephraim realizes he has been living unclean/unholy life all these years. He realizes there is no difference between him and a heathen so he must act now.

Luke 15:19 and I am no longer worthy to be called your son. Make me like one of your hired servants." '

Ephraim knows all this weekly worship is worthless for him and not building him up but depressing him when he looks around himself where people have no real knowledge of the holy one of Israel and no relationship to Him. He does not even see himself worthy being amongst the heathen nations.

Luke 15:20 "And he arose and came to his father. But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and **ran and fell on his neck** and kissed him.

The Father ran and fell on his neck is a very Hebraic term as the book of Luke was also written in Hebrew and not Greek. The Father has compassion on His returning son. The effort was made by the son to return to His Hebrew roots and then the Father helped him. Once you start naming the true name of YHWH you will see a floodgate of Truth will open to you and the name will lead you to the Father's house full of jewels, gold and silver the beauty of YHWH being revealed to you in His holy sanctuary that is permanently located in Heaven soon to be also modeled on earth.

Luke 15:21 "And the son said to him, ` Father, I have sinned against heaven and in your sight, and am no longer worthy to be called your son.'

Keeping Christ-mass and using the name of Ishtar is a sin and the son Ephraim realizes and

asks his father for forgiveness that not only is he sinning but he says to Him I am not worthy to be your son while many in Churches think it is ok and they are once saved always saved even in their idolatries.

Luke 15:22 "But the father said to his servants, `Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet.

The Father accepts His son even though he was living in complete and utter idolatry because he made a conscious choice to search out for his real home and wanted to return (repent) to the true faith. It may be obvious to some that It's not about church catechisms and little prayers but it's about our walk/halacha and our action that speak loudly about our faith but be careful friends because most church Pastor's are still stuck in the church book which dictates to them what today's sermon is about, what catechism he is going to use today, what words the people should be reading on a piece of card.

This also shows even though people do not fully understand Torah, prophets and the other writings but YHWH is gracious to forgive them their sin to allow them in the kingdom those with repentant hearts. The son made a conscious choice to turn around, the Hebrew word "shuv" means to turn away from doing something evil to something right in the Father's eyes so a conscious choice has to be made to repent and turn away from sin. We must make the conscious choice to return and learn our Hebrew faith. There is a price that those will pay who claim to live in grace and ignore His Torah.

The three symbols of authority in the story of the prodigal

Robe White robe of salvation

Isa 61:10 I greatly rejoice in יהוה my being exults in my Elohim. For He has put garments of deliverance on me, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Ring Signet of authority that he has royal approval and authority of the King of Kings

YHWH and is a member of Israel a nation of kings and priests. **Its YHWH's sign of acceptance.**

Rev 5:10 And hast made us unto our Elohim kings and priests: and **we shall reign on the earth.**

1Pe 2:9 But ye *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:

Sandals The sandals are to wear on the feet. The son was "dead", in the middle-east a slave walks bare foot but a son wears sandals/shoes so we see why he was given these to show that he is now alive and FREE and no longer DEAD.

Nah 1:15 Behold upon the mountains the feet of him that bringeth good tidings, that publisheth peace!

You only proclaim good news if you are free not if you are a slave!

Luke 15:23 And bring the fatted calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry;

There is a table waiting for the bride to celebrate with the Bridegroom.

Luke 15:24 'for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' And they began to be merry.

Important points to note which are often missed!

He was dead

He was lost

He has been found

Do these terms sound like the prodigal was saved while in the gentile nations? No. Each term is clear. In his sin he was dead, he was lost and later when he turned around (Shuv) back to the covenants of Israel, remembered his Father meaning the one who gave the covenants, remembering is the term in Scripture also for "please Elohim do me a favor and save me". Friends, the Renewed Covenant is Israel's covenant our covenant and leads us back to Torah truth to the living Torah the Messiah of Israel. In order to have the covenant one must live by the terms of the Covenant that sadly many lack to understand.

The example here illustrates that the prodigal son when living in the wilderness was dead he did not even know what repentance was he was quite happy to go to church on Sunday and live in death hearing the social gospel. We all have a conscious choice to make wake up and return to our covenants or stay DEAD.

The real turn around came when he decided that enough was enough, he could not live like this and had to make a conscious choice to turn away from all that is wrong and return (allegorical and literal) repentance brought life to the son. He thought I will return to the Father well what is our Father's name? It is YHWH pronounced by many of us as Yahuweh. When we make a conscious choice to know about our Father, His name, His ways then the Ruach of Elohim (Holy Spirit) will start to open up ALL truth to us as the Ruach is the "Spirit of truth" and will lead us to ALL truth (John 16:13). The Holy Spirit must then lead us back home, back to Israel, back to the covenants, back to our rich heritage.

Luke 15:25 "Now his older son was in the field. And as he came and drew near to the house, he heard music and dancing.

The older son is Judah and has a problem with Ephraim who squandered all the wealth meaning no regards to Torah.

Isa 11:13 And the **envy of Ephrayim** shall turn aside, and the adversaries of Yehudah be cut off. Ephrayim shall not envy Yehudah, and **Yehudah not trouble Ephrayim.**

He knew he was right and he kept Torah, kept the feasts, worshipped YHWH as expected of him and even hid the name of YHWH to protect it from foreigners so they would not mispronounce it.

Luke 15:25-26 "Now his older son was in the field. And as he came and drew near to the house, he heard music and dancing. (26) "So he called one of the servants and asked what these things meant.

Judah was "in the field" (allegorical world) busy with teaching the world who come to him to Israel, in the end of days many righteous teachers will come out of Judah saved in the blood of Messiah. Judah is confused and thinking hang on, I am the one keeping the Torah, Sabbaths, feasts yet what is this noise for Ephraim.

Luke 15:27 "And he said to him, `Your brother has come, and because he has received him safe and sound, your father has killed the fatted calf.'

The younger son has returned to Torah. In the middle-east it is culturally appropriate to receive a guest and then kill a calf to prepare a feast meaning the guest is welcome home and everyone is invited to the feast. Here the allegory is to the wedding feast where both brothers are united by the King Messiah.

Luke 15:28-29 "But he was angry and would not go in. Therefore his father came out and pleaded with him. (29) "So he answered and said to his father, `Lo, these many years I have been serving you; I never transgressed your commandment at any time; and yet you never gave me a young goat, that I might make merry with my friends.

Judah pleads he has been keeping Torah all this time but no mention was made of him and no parties thrown. It is true that not only were no parties thrown but poor Judah the elder brother was persecuted while the younger lived in harlotry.

Luke 15:30 But as soon as this son of yours came, who has devoured your livelihood with harlots, you killed the fatted calf for him.'

"**Living with harlots**" means he did not keep Torah yet still receives the wedding party.

Luke 15:31 "And he said to him, `Son, you are always with me, and all that I have is yours.

Many Christians need to pay a close attention to this. Judah was always close to the Father and the Father says "all that I have is yours". This is admonishment for Christianity to stop converting Jewish people to non-torah and uncleanness. They need to be completed with the Messiah by repentance but not convert to a new religion and start behaving and living like pagans. If you are a Christian and see the clear need to turn around from your unclean ways

then now is the time to make repentance (Teshuvah) turn around and obey all the commandments as written in the Torah and written in the Prophets, Psalms and repeated in the Renewed Covenant writings.
