

Two Houses - The House of Israel in Exile

Israel was one nation up to the times of King Solomon and after his idolatry and misbehaving with God he was told that the United Kingdom of Israel would be divided but not in his life but after his life and become two nations.

Abrahamic-Faith Nazarene Hebraic Study Scriptures

1 Kings 11:11 Therefore אֱלֹהִים said to Solomon, "Because you have done this, and have not kept **My covenant** and **My statutes**, which I have commanded you, I will surely tear the kingdom away from you and give it to your servant.

Patriarchal plural marriages are allowed in the Torah (Exo 21:10) but with responsibility and King Solomon allowed himself to become irresponsible in handling his kingdom and his many wives by allowing them to worship false elohim.

1 Kings 11:12 "Nevertheless I will not do it in your days, for the sake of your father David; but I will tear it out of the hand of your son.

YHWH promised not to tear the kingdom and divide it in King Solomon's time but his son's time as a king. This was the beginning of the birth of the Ten Tribes and the two nations in the same land of Israel in the mind of YHWH.

1 Kings 11:30-32 Then Ahiyah took hold of the new garment that was on him, and tore it into **twelve pieces**. (31) And he said to Yeroboam, "Take for yourself **ten pieces**, for thus says אֱלֹהִים the Elohim of Israel: `Behold, I will tear the kingdom out of the hand of Shlomo (Solomon) and will give ten tribes to you (32) (but he shall have one tribe for the sake of My servant Dawud, and for the sake of Yerushalayim (Jerusalem), the city which I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel),

Enter Abraham

The origins of this really go back to our father Abraham that is if you accept him as the father of your faith? Abraham was seventy five years old when God Elohim told him that He would bless him and join all the families of the earth unto him but how could this be possible since Abraham did not even have a son at that time, his wife Sarah was infertile and they were getting on in age.

In the Jewish ArtScroll Bible Series, Volume 1, page 432, it is written:

There is ... an opinion shared by Rashbam [to Genesis 28:14], Chizkuni, Da'as Zekeinim, and quoted by Tur that the verb (ve nivrecu) in Genesis 12:3 is related to the root barak as in the Mishnaic term mavreek meaning to "intermingle or graft." [cf Kelaim 7:1, Sotah 43a.] As Heidenheim explains it, this interpretation is inspired by the fact that nowhere else besides here do we find barak in the sense of **blessing in the niphal conjugation**, while in the sense of "**grafting**" it is common in that form. [Bold emphasis mine]

NKJV Genesis 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; And in you [Abraham] ALL the families of the earth Nivrecu [**will be grafted in**] [brackets mine]

Genesis 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you all the mispachot of the earth shall be blessed."

Here God Elohim had started to unfold the plan of salvation for the world through Abraham and thus Abraham in wording was told that families would be joined to him i.e. engrafted in him. This though seems impossible given the circumstances of Abraham but God was going to perform a superb miracle so that both Abraham and Sarah would know that walking in faith and truthfulness has an immense blessing and can bring wonderful new opportunities in life.

God had promised Abraham in **Genesis 15:4-5** that He would give Abraham a son and make his descendants as numerous as the stars. Now if Abraham was going to have a son (Isaac) and through that son his descendants were going to multiply like the stars in the sky then surely the nation of Israel today with just the two tribes that is Judah and Benjamin with albeit a few other members from the ten tribes do not meet that promise and as yet still to be fulfilled. The other problem is that the nation of Israel and its members can be counted but the descendants of Abraham were meant to be immeasurable as stars in the sky.

A turning point for Jacob's family

Genesis 35:9-11 Then Elohim appeared to Jacob again, when he came from Padan Aram, and blessed him. (10) And Elohim said to him, "Your name is Jacob; your name shall not be called Jacob anymore, but Yisrael shall be your name." So He called his name Yisrael. (11) Also Elohim said to him: "I am Elohim Almighty. Be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall proceed from you, and kings shall come from your body."

Ya'acov in Hebrew יעקב

God changed Jacob's name from Jacob to Yisrael that means "upright with Elohim". Getting a name change in the Middle-Eastern culture also means a nature change so here Jacob is given fresh anointing with unfolding prophesies and opportunities that were to be fulfilled through his children the 12 sons to become the tribes of Yisrael. God also tells him to "be fruitful" the Hebrew words Parats literally means **to burst forth** or **break forth** into many people. It is good for believers in Yahushua to have a name change at or after the onset of their new birth a more appropriate Hebrew name to reflect the inner reality of your outer being. I was called Mohammed before Yahushua saved me and thus after my salvation I changed my name to Simon, in Hebrew Shimon means "the one who heard Elohim" because He called and I heard His voice.

Some other interesting things in **Genesis 35:9-11**, notice Yisrael is referred to as a goy (nation) and also Qahal goyim (Assembly of nations) here, therefore we can see that God had started to separate the two house of Yisrael e.g. goy (Yisrael) and Qahal Goyim (10 tribes that were to spread in the world) though this division was not revealed until after the time of King Solomon.

Thus in 931BC King Solomon's kingdom was split into north and south Yisrael ruled by two kings. Jeroboam is the king mentioned in scriptures for ruling the northern tribes of Yisrael e.g. the 10 tribes (Ephraim). Here we encounter the term House of Yisrael in 1 Kings 12:21 not for the collective twelve tribes but only for the northern kingdom Ephraim. King Jeroboam took the Northern tribes into idolatry by introducing cow worship and introducing new feast days. The parallels are present in modern Christianity of both cow worship where "Jesus" is come with a new law that does away with what was given to Moses and new feast dates.

Of course ask any in these churches and they cannot see that they are not worshipping the one Elohim of Israel called God but some new man called "Jesus" who has no connection to Israel and that through him they instituted new doctrines that are false such as away with the old and in with the new. This was the sin of King Jeroboam. However the Real Yahushua who came upholding the Torah He gave to Moses said this:

Revelation 2:5 "Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place unless you repent.

So He the Messiah of Israel the true Elohim warns them to repent and return to their first works which was obeying the Torah He gave to Moses.

It's very interesting how God's usage of the term the "House of Yisrael" is not for All tribes but the counted 10 tribes only.

Jeremiah 3:4-5 Hear the word of YHWH, O house of Jacob and all the families of the house of Yisrael. (5) Thus says YHWH: "What injustice have your fathers found in Me, that they have gone far from Me, have followed idols, and have become idolaters?"

Notice the pattern here the whole twelve tribes had not yet gone into captivity but only the 10 northern tribes but the writer addresses first the whole house (Jacob the twelve tribes) and then the ten northern tribes as the "house of Yisrael". The church today commits the same sin as the house of Yisrael namely setting up their own holy days such as Christ-mass and Easter (false deity name of Ishtar) yet Scripture gives no authority to such days. No wonder for 1800 years such idolatrous practices have continued in the churches without any fear of God or what He may think of these man made feasts!

Any sensible person only has to read the account of King Jeroboam to come to a realisation that these are not acceptable in any modern shape or form. The Holy days that the Bible asks us to celebrate are mentioned in Leviticus 23/Deuteronomy 16 such as Passover Pentecost and Tabernacles but only a few Christians know about them and these are deliberately ignored by many such Christians who simply want to argue and hold to the pagan papal feasts while calling the other ones Jewish in their ignorance. They misapply grace by thinking that God Elohim does not care about Israel proper but forget it was this particular sin precisely that caused the great offence to God and for Him to scatter Ephraim in His anger.

The time has now come that once again that God will punish these sins and many people will either be removed from the true Elohim of Yisrael or be grafted in as the seed of Abraham. I am making sure that I am here presenting as much material to the opposite argument in favour of the feasts of God and I even offer a book written on the subject that can be purchased here. <http://www.abrahamic-faith.com/Books/books.html> one called The Feasts of YHWH the Elohim of Israel.

First came their scattering for disobedience

Leviticus 26:33 And **I will scatter you** among the heathen, and will draw out a sword after you: and your land shall be desolate, and your cities waste.

The House of Yisrael did become like pagans and behaved in the same way and acted the pagan habits but God's plan was to mix them with the heathens and let them return with repentance recognising their Messiah and their roots. The sin was disobedience. Also sadly not all of the Northern tribes will return Scripture tells us that a remnant will heed this call and return.

Leviticus 26:14-16 But if ye will not hearken unto me, and will not do all these commandments; (15) And if ye shall despise my statutes, or if your soul abhor my judgments, so that ye will not do all my commandments, but that ye break my covenant: (16) I also will do this to you: I will even appoint terror over you, wasting disease and fever which shall consume the eyes and cause sorrow of heart. And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it.

On the Drash level the trouble was both Houses of Yisrael suffered for their disobedience and literally God brought terror upon them which sadly transpired in the form of pogroms, burnings and evictions from countries. Now that Yisrael has been established since 1948 the time of the pogroms are over provided the Hebrew people recognise their home. Anti-Semitism still brews in churches and shamefully many Christians who are biological and spiritual Ephraimites still persecute their Judean brothers ascribing all the blessings of God to themselves and all the curses to the Jews and these frankly are pointed reasons why the Jews today cannot get along with the church.

The Pashat level Israel will be in trouble and that terror will be from the nations they are in and from roundabout that means Islamic nations and not Christians or some others.

1 plus 1 equals 2 house of Yisrael e.g. the 12 tribes

Jeremiah 31:31 "Behold, the days are coming," says YHWH, "when I will make a new covenant with the **house of Yisrael** and with the **house of Judah**

1+1=2 House

Isaiah 8:14 He will be as a sanctuary, but a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense to **both the houses of Yisrael**, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

1+1=2 Nations and also 2 countries

Ezekiel 35:10 "Because you have said, 'These TWO NATIONS and these TWO COUNTRIES shall be mine, and we will possess them,' although YHWH was there,

Who said that these two nations are mine? Muslims said this and they want to drive the Jewish people out to the sea so this is why Lev 26 is about Islam as above.

1+1=2 sticks

Ezekiel 37:16 "As for you, son of man, take a stick for yourself and write on it: 'For Judah and for the children of Yisrael, his companions.' Then take another stick and write on it, 'For Joseph, the stick of Ephraim, and for all the house of Yisrael, his companions.'

Not just two sticks but two trees made into one. The Hebrew word for tree is Etz which is used here to denote two trees. Remember Paul told us you are the wild olive tree and there is one the natural olive tree.

Isaiah 11:12 He will set up a banner for the nations, and will assemble the outcasts of Yisrael, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the four corners of the earth.

These are but some scriptures to confirm that the truth of two house is a reality taking place and that whether Christians see it or not is irrelevant to how God sees it. He sees the two families and one cannot find a single reference for a covenant of God to an entity called "the church". Those that are in the churches today and call themselves Christians do largely belong to the outcasts of Yisrael (Ephraim group) in one form or another, they maybe people from Judah as well but spiritually and Biologically these are Yisraelites rightful heirs in the 12 tribes of Yisrael. There are even Muslims and Hindus who belong to the House of Yisrael, perhaps over time they will recognise the Elohim of Yisrael as His Spirit works in their lives or if not they will perish, only time will tell. I have found one thing that even messianic Christian groups show a hatred for the two houses and wrongly call this anti-Semitism. This is the sort of ridiculous theory you have to believe that the most normal of Biblical theologies which espouses the joining of the two sticks into one or into the one flock of Yahushua is anti-Semitic.

Unfortunately the truth is that the hardening that happened is not just to Jewish Yisrael but also to Ephraim Yisrael (Romans 11:25) since both get the nourishment from the same olive tree. The Christians are hardened not to see the relevance of the Torah they would rather celebrate pagan Christ-mass but the Jewish Yisrael is hardened to see their Messiah. Well the messianic some of them are hardened to see the two house, different levels of this hardening exists and they all try to justify themselves.

Exodus 19:6 'And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words which you shall speak to the children of Yisrael."

Earlier signs of this split were shown in the items of the tabernacle, the Two Loaves of Bread

The two loafs of bread on the table in the Tabernacle/Temple were the representation of the two Houses, the House of Israel and the House of Judah, Ephraim is the Drash Allegoric and physical picture of the church therefore both houses are united under the ONE olive tree that is Israel.

There is only one "Tree" that is Israel and returning goyim (gentiles) are grafted IN to this tree then how is it that we have replacement theology but in fact it should be IN PLACE theology because we were "**in placed**" of the disbelieving Jewish people into the root. This is what Paul correctly understood and wrote about.

Romans 11:17 And if **some of the branches were broken off**, and **you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them**, and **with them became a partaker of the root** and fatness of the olive tree

Please note these spiritual principles:

We are wild branches grafted "in".

The word is "scion" for a young shoot for grafting "in" to the root stock. The grafting is done to a side.

- Yahushua was pierced in His side.
- Adam's side was opened to remove bones and flesh.
- The grafted in branch can take up to 3 days to settle.
- The grafted in branch takes up to 3 years to yield fruit.

Isaiah 11:1 There shall come forth a **Rod from the stem of Jesse**, and a **Branch [Netzer] shall grow out of his roots**.

This is Drash (Allegoric) for the Messiah Yahushua but how about that it is also symbolic and physical for the Christian nation that grew out believing in the Messiah! The Hebrew word for "branch" in Isaiah 11:1 is NETZER and so the early believers were called Nazarenes or Notzarim (Followers of The Branch).

Reality check

Many Christians think that they can do whatever they like and still be saved!!!!

Romans 11:21 For if Elohim did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either.

The Bible teaches that if God cut off the natural branches "Israel for their unbelief" then why should we be any special?

Salvation is a gift (Ephesians 2:8) but that does not mean we have a license for sin, we can read it in Matthew that when Yahushua returns, half of us will be asleep and not even able to enter the kingdom of Elohim. Have you ever wondered why that is?

Matthew 25:1-12 "Then the kingdom of heaven shall be likened to **ten virgins [Ten tribes]** who took their lamps and went out to meet the **bridegroom**. (2) "Now **five of them were wise**, and **five were foolish**. (6) "And at midnight a cry was heard: `Behold, the **bridegroom is coming**; [Yahushua will return unexpectedly just like Noah's flood] go out to meet Him!" (10) "And while they went to buy, the Bridegroom came, and those who were ready [the ones who obeyed His instructions] went in with him to the wedding; and the door was shut.

(11) "Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open to us!' (12)
"But He answered and said, 'Assuredly, I say to you, I do not **know** you.'

You can know of Yahushua but not necessarily know Him in a relationship], like I know of the queen of England but not necessarily in a relationship.

Five virgins were wise and five were foolish – This is 50% of the Church today. This is a Drash (Allegorical truth) this is teaching a true lesson of our day, I do not think that everybody in churches or those wearing crosses are saved, you can wear a cross and still be unsaved and you can attend a church and still be unsaved. The bottom line is, "do not be a foolish virgin" but be obedient and remain faithful and steadfast and while you are doing that be careful the early church did not use the cross as a symbol as that is a Babylonian pagan symbol. The symbol for believers is a menorah and not a cross.

Romans 11:25 For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise **in your own opinion**, that **hardening in part has happened to Israel** until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.

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Romans 11:25 For I would not, my Yah'sar'aelite brothers and sisters, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, and you should be wise in your own conceit; that blindness in part is happened to Yisrael, until the fullness of the returning Gentiles (Melo ha Goyim) comes in.

Isaiah 8:14 He will be as a sanctuary, but a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense to both the houses of Israel, as a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Scripture tells us in Isaiah 8:14 that the stone will be an offence to both the houses of Israel and we know why this is since western Christianity has never really presented a loving Messiah to the Jewish people and have always sought to convert the Jewish people into a paganised Christian faith which breaks the laws of God's Torah and aims to convert a person into Christianity. It's a misnomer to convert a Jewish man to Christianity because if he finds his Messiah Yahushua then he becomes a completed Jew and does not need to convert to anything and likewise we need to be completed in our faith by being obedient to Torah and not force pork down the Jewish people's proverbial throat and also we need to keep the unclean substance away from our mouths. Its filthy, its unhealthy and its wrong by God's law plain and simple.

If a hardening in part (partial) is of Israel then what about the gentiles who are also grafted into the **same tree**? Both have a partial blindness because we take our nourishment from the same root thus the returning gentiles have the Messiah but hate Torah observance and the Jewish nation hate Yahushua as the Messiah but love Torah (Oral and written Torah), in fact these gentiles are returning Ephramites, we must understand it and believe it as scripture is explicit in many places but some of us refuse to see this, the Bible is a Hebrew book and for the Hebrew people so why argue and try to make it a Hellenist text. Some Christians in the churches are conceited about this issue and think they are wise. His instructions are not about do and don'ts but about our willingness and desire to serve Him, we may fail on many things but He does not mark us on a sheet of paper 24 hours a day on what we get right and what we don't. We live under grace by being faithful to His commandments that means those commandments in

the Torah that apply to us in the absence of the Temple and it is those that endure to the END that will enter the kingdom of Heaven.

What Paul saw was clearly what was prophesied to Abraham in **Genesis 12:3**.

2 Chronicles 7:14 and My people upon whom My Name is called, shall humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their evil ways, then I shall hear from the heavens, and forgive their sin and heal their land.

His grace is enough for us as long as we are willingly able to show a serious response to His call. Torah obedience is not about what I get right and what I get wrong, this idea is not what God intended, if this was so then while Israel is in the Diaspora would she would never ever be able to return back to the "land" because they would never be able to keep the Torah fully because if there was no Temple and no priesthood so how could they ever obey the Torah fully without these elements? The reference from 2 Chr 7:14 would be meaningless if Israel could not live righteously in the Diaspora since Daniel proved this is possible and we do not need a Temple for our obedience to be shown. The Temple will come at its appointed time.

Deuteronomy 30:1-4 "Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the **blessing and the curse which I have set before you**, and you call them to **mind among all the nations where the Lord your Elohim drives you**, (2) "and you return to **YHWH your Elohim and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today**, you and your children, with **all your heart and with all your soul**, (3) "that the Lord your Elohim **will bring you back from captivity**, and have **compassion on you**, and gather you again from all the nations where YHWH your Elohim has scattered you. (4) "If any of you are driven out to the farthest parts under heaven, from there the Lord your Elohim will gather you, and from there He will bring you.

The same thing applies to **Deuteronomy 30:1-4** if Israel was able to keep a perfect Torah without a Tabernacle and priesthood, the idea was not about keeping the Torah perfectly this is wrong teaching again by the church. YHWH's compassion is upon His people because of the promises He made with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Israel was never able to keep a perfect Torah and those that think Israel did would have to just look at the sacrificial system in the Tenach to know that this was never the case. Salvation for Israel always came through **GRACE by FAITH** shocking but true and not rigid do and don'ts or via good deeds. Those that think it did are mistaken and wilfully ignorant of Biblical text. Why would God give a sacrificial system if men could obey every detail of His word, it simply does not make sense?

We know God seeks after an **obedient heart**, a heart of flesh and Israel is back in the Land today because many Jewish people though fail on many things but try their best while gentiles shun the Jewish people and even persecute anyone who even advocates that God's Torah is eternal yet we know salvation has already come through Yahushua our Messiah and His blood sacrifice so if you failed on Torah you are not condemned but do you show a willing heart or do you just shun it because this is what you learnt in the Church? In the end there is a price and this price will be paid by **You** when you stand before God for breaking His Torah commandments.

Remember the dragon (Satan) persecutes those who keep His commandments and have the testimony of Yahushua the Messiah; you are not a threat to Satan if you do

Revelation 12:17 And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, **who keep the commandments of Elohim** and **have the testimony of Yahushua Moshiach**.

The salvation of the gentiles was revealed to Abraham many millennia ago when he was told:

Genesis 12:3 I will bless those who bless you, and I will curse him who curses you; and in you **ALL the families of the earth shall be blessed**.

Let's look at what this really means, that God is teaching us here that through Abraham ALL the families of the earth will be blessed.

In English it may not be so obvious but in Hebrew the verse for "In you ALL the families of the earth shall be blessed" reads "**Ve Nivrechu Bekah Kol Mishpachot HA-Adamah.**"

There is a deep profound truth here that is again hidden in the English translation and is nowhere near translated as the Biblical Hebrew declares. The Hebrew word used here "Nivrechu" is translated as "be blessed", however the actual Hebrew word used for "be blessed" is not "Yivrechu" but "Nivrechu". In the Jewish Rabbinic opinion this word is more correctly translated "intermingled" or to be "grafted in".

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When we look at the underlining language and what the Jewish sages have agreed we come to a very rich understanding of what God Elohim was trying to do here, now let's read the text with this proper understanding.

Genesis 12:3b And in you [Abraham] **ALL the families of the earth Nivrechu. [will be grafted IN]**

Now when you go and read Paul in his epistles you get a better understanding of what he really meant when he wrote in Romans 11:17 and about a great mystery.

Romans 11:17 And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were **grafted in among them**, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree.

It is quite obvious Paul was doing a Midrash (commentary) on **Genesis 12:3** and understood what this really meant, important point to note about our friend Paul here is

that we must always interpret Paul in context with the Torah, whenever we dissect Paul's teaching outside the Torah and first century Judaism (s) the interpretation would be incorrect like many who misinterpret his Galatians passages to annul the Torah.

Elohim revealed the Torah more fully at Mount Sinai and codified it for Israel that is the only difference so they could communicate it to the world and by their own personal way of life show these things to gentile nations around them. Sure not ALL the commandments are for us such as the Levitical priestly laws but what is not for us we do not have to keep but what is for us we should obey. The total of 613 commandments of which 248 positive and 365 negative commands are all for us but not all applicable at the same time. The sages believe that the body has 248 organs and 365 sinews making the man equalling the 613 commandments.

Genesis 8:20 Then Noah built an altar to YHWH, and took of every **clean** animal and of every **clean** bird, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

How did Noah know about clean and unclean animals? Let those who want to separate Torah and grace prove that Noah and Abraham did not have the Torah since Both these are called faithful and obeyed HIS TORAH that He had revealed to them so **GRACE and TORAH (commandments of God)** flow hand in hand, they cannot be separated. Elohim has been graceful throughout time. Torah really means instructions and no more really.

This is why King David rightly said.

Psalms 136:1 Oh give thanks unto YHWH, for He is good! For His Grace endureth forever.

Genesis 26:4-5 I will **multiply your descendants** as the stars of heaven, and will give to your descendants all these lands; and by your descendants all the nations of the earth shall bless themselves: Because **Abraham obeyed My Voice** and **kept My Charge, My Commandments, My Statutes, and My Torah!**

This proves the eternity of the Torah whether we care to believe it or not.
